SCHOOL RULES

The parents in general and Bhaiyas / Bahans, in particular MUST abide by the rules of the school mentioned below:-

- 1. School expects from its Bhaiyas / Bahans to religiously abide by the rules and regulations as furnished from time to time.
- 2. Bhaiyas / Bahans are expected to ever remain obedient and devoted to their Acharyajees (teachers) so as to ensure a very healthy, positive and rewarding academic atmosphere.
- 3. Bhaiyas / Bahans are expected to have a sense of devotion to Maa Saraswati, goddess of education and learning; and keep all the stationeries, Text Books, Exercise Books etc. properly.
- 4. Bhaiyas / Bahans are expected to attend school not only in complete & well tailored but also in neat and clean and well pressed School Uniform.
- 5. Bhaiyas / Bahans are expected to regard their school as a Temple of Learning; and hence they must have a high moral of the institution they are reading in.
- 6. No scholar is allowed to keep with himself/herself things like money in cash, watch, calculator, necklace, ring, camera, transistor, video games, cell phones, I-pod etc. Scholars who come to school by their own arrangement may have money in cash but as per need.
- 7. No student is allowed to bring any kind of electronic device.
- 8. Any type of conduct against the institutional character shall be deemed as serious delinquency and shall be liable to severe punishment.
- School fees must be deposited in time and cleared before the commencement of Term Exams.
- 10. Students are expected to come to school on due time with their Tiffin Box not full of junk foods but with home made nutritious food stuffs.
- 11. Each and every Bhaiya / Bahan is expected to bring School Diary & Vandana Book daily.
- 12. Bhaiyas / Bahans are expected to talk in good English in a very noble way. When expected to speak in Sanskrit, they should make sincere effort for the same too.
- 13. Repeated violation of any of the above rules may compel the management to consider the case as a serious one and ultimately decision may be taken to send the child back to home.
- 14. There is no provision to refund any fee other than security money.

Expulsion

- Any Student (Bhaiya / Bahan) may be debarred from the class who does not follow the school rules.
- Irregular attendance / habitual idleness / disobedience / lack of cooperation / evidence of misconduct / evidence of damaging the school property is sufficient reason for expulsion / dismissal from the school.

School Transport System

- School provides vehicle facilities to the extent of its capacity.
- Bhaiya/Bahan should board the vehicle designated for him / her.
- He / she should not get down at any other stop without permission of the Principal and Vehicle In Charge.
- Parents themselves should arrange to see the children off to the vehicle stop and also receive them.
- All the Bhaiyas / Bahans availing vehicle facility must reach the stop on time.
- In case the school vehicle does not ply due to unavoidable circumstances, the parents have to bring their children to school and take them back by their own means.
- Vehicle fee is payable for full session



Other Specialities

- Teaching Method: For all-round development of our students we use Panchapadi teaching method which includes Adhiti, Bodha, Abhyas, Prasar and Pravachan with five dimensional monitoring which include Physical, Mental, Moral, Vocational as well as spiritual aspects.
- Curriculum: We follow the Curriculum of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (CBSE) and the textbooks of NCERT
- 3 Teaching Medium: The common medium for teaching different subjects is English. Hindi and Sanskrit subjects are taught in direct method.
- 4. **Co-Education :** We have co-education system in our school. The boy and girl call each other as Bhaiya and Bahan, and the students take each-other in the same spirit.
- **5. Kakshanayak and Kakshacharya**: In each class there are several sections. Each section has a Kakshanayak and a Kakshacharya who takes personal care of each student of that section.
- **Examination System :** Each academic session includes Two Terms Exams. and Three Periodic Tests. After completion of a lesson or unit from the book there is a provision of Unit Test. Progress reports are sent to the parents within ten days of completion of each Assessment / Test.
- 7. Promotion Criteria: Promotion to the next class requires a minimum 90% of class attendance and 70% marks in each subject.
- 8. No need of Private Tuition: There is no need of private tuition for students enrolled in our school. Our classroom teaching is interactive in which the students are encouraged to ask questions and clear their doubts in the classroom instantly.
- 9. Monitoring: There is a provision of monitoring period on every working day in which the class teacher and Kakshanayak take care of nails and hair. School uniforms and diaries are also checked daily. The books, copies and the daily diary entry of each student is monitored.
- **10. Acharyas :** The Acharyas or the teachers are well-qualified, trained, experienced and dedicated towards overall development of the students in friendly manner.
- 11. Prayer: All students and teachers assemble in the Assembly Hall for prayer and meditation. The prayer is totally based on Sanatan Vyavastha.
- 12. Academic Session: Each Academic session begins in the month of April and ends in the month of March.
- 13. Computer Education: Computer education is compulsory from class one onwards.
- 14. Parents-Teachers Meet: In each academic session Parents-Teachers meet is essentially held after the Terms examination. Parents can contact subject teacher, class teacher or principal whenever they want.
- 15. Lunch: On every working day there is a Lunch session in which all students take their home made lunch in the school hall after reciting the Bhojana Mantra.

- **Medical Care**: First Aid in case of emergency is available in the school. From time to time a team of doctors examines the health status of students.
- 17. Masanta Baithak: Every month on its last working day the classes remain suspended for the students. On this day the teachers assemble with the Principal to analyze the last month's experience in the school and plan for the next month.
- 18. Bal Sansad: Two Chhatra Sansad (Student Parliament) events are organized every year. The students from class one to five have Shishu Bharati and the students from class six and above have Bal Bharati. In the two sansads the entire activities of the year are performed. Various responsibilities are also alloted to the students. This way the students learn about co-operation, division of work and citizenship. If they require, they get help from their teachers in conducting this activity.
- 19. Sport: Annual sports events are organised every year.
- 20. Yoga: Yoga Classes are arranged weekly.
- 21. Transport: Transportation facilities are available also.
- **22. Admission Test:** For Admission, a Entrance Test is organized in which objective questions are asked in Hindi, English, Math and General Awareness from the standard they have passed.
- 23. Minimum age for Admission is six (06) years in standard one (1) as on 1st April and the same is followed in ascending order for admission in a particular class.
- **24. Personality Development :** For developing the latent capabilities of the students debates, group discussions and the Jayanti celebration of Mahapurushas are regularly held.
- **25. Alumni**: The pass out students share a lively relation with the school. Whenever they come to Patna, they visit the school. Annual Alumni meet is organized every year.

Excursion

Educational tours are planned according to the needs of the classes. Short distance small [1 day] excursions in winter are there for the junior pupils while long and big [7 days] ones in summer for the senior ones.
